

BLAKE COLLETON WINS STATE TITLE ON KX65 !



Junior KRT rider, Blake Colleton, has clinched the 65cc 10-12 years QLD Title on board his Kawasaki KX65 at the last round of the 2008 QLD Motocross Series at Kilcoy on 27 April.

After posting the fastest lap time on his way to winning the 2nd round at Gladstone, Blake has gone on to achieve the fastest lap time again at the Kilcoy track in the 3rd round. Blake finished the final round in 3rd place, securing enough points to win the State Title.

Blake also competes on board his Kawasaki KX85 in the 85cc class and managed to finish inside the top 10 taking 9th place in the series.
